

The CW's Rock the Park Hawaii episodes to begin airing Saturday

The CW's Rock the Park, a 30-minute television show where hosts Jack Steward and Colton Smith visit America's most popular national parks, will air two episodes featuring Maui's Haleakala National Park and the Big Island's Hawaii Volcanoes National Park starting this Saturday.

The premier of the Hawaii episodes also happens to take place during National Park Week April 18-26.

The **Hawaii Visitors and Convention Bureau**, the **Hawaii Tourism Authority's** marketing contractor for North America, assisted with the production.

The Haleakala episode, airing April 18, features the hosts taking a zipline through mountain slopes, biking down from Haleakala's summit, hiking through a bamboo forest, paddleboarding in Hana Bay and visiting a bird sanctuary.
